
Project News Update - Issue 17 - February 2024



We are pleased to bring you our February newsletter for the exciting major redevelopment project at Skinners' Hall.

Works undertaken in the last month:

- Commence decoration in the Dowgate Range ground floor
- Lime wash samples in the Quatro Vaults
- Strike the temporary scaffold roof to Great Hall
- Continue M&E 1st fix to new Wallbrook men & women's facilities
- M&E 1st fix Pavilion roof
- Gilding the Great Hall ceiling
- Install Kitchen units to first floor Dowgate Range
- Remove bottom of sashes and build up new levels in Wallbrook Terrace
- Removed all protection to the old and new courtrooms and begin new window restoration works
- Completed restoration and reinstatement of the historic floorboards in the Dowgate Range
- Installation of the salvaged Purbeck stone flooring in the Dowgate Range basement



Forthcoming Works

- Continue decoration in the Dowgate Range ground floor
- Install Portuguese Atlantic Blue limestone staircase to Wallbrook staircase 14
- Install Ironmongery and continue restoration and re hanging of doors in the Dowgate Range
- Decorating and painting the walls and ceilings of the Quattro vaults
- Installed all doors in the Dowgate Range including ironmongery
