
Project News Update - Issue 18 - March 2024



We are pleased to bring you our March newsletter for the exciting major redevelopment project at Skinners' Hall.

Works undertaken in the last month:

- Completed decorations to the upper levels of the Dowgate Range and Link with snagging underway
- Installed light fittings with testing and commissioning in progress
- Continued to lay limestone paving in the basement areas
- Installed timber wall panelling to the changing areas
- Completed decorations to the Great Hall ceiling which will enable removal of the birdcage scaffold within
- Installed the stainless steel roof finish on the Pavilion
- Installed oak screens to the Pavilion
- Continued M & E installation across the project
- Begun closing up of partitions and ceilings in Wallbrook basement
- Commenced installation of the limestone stairs in ST14
- · Commenced restoration of timber panelling and sash windows in the Court and committee rooms
- Continued repointing of the facades to the court and committee rooms



Forthcoming Works

- Continue snagging the Dowgate Range and Link
- Install carpets to the Range and Link
- Install the decorative screening to the roof plant above the outer hall
- Commence works to the Wallbrook roof deck
- Continue limestone paving in the Quattro vaults
- Commence plastering in the Wallbrook basement
- Continue panelling restoration in the Court and Committee rooms
- Begin lime washing the Quattro vaults
