We are pleased to issue our March newsletter for the construction project at Windsor Street, where we are building 11 units of supported housing accommodation for Islington residents with learning disabilities.

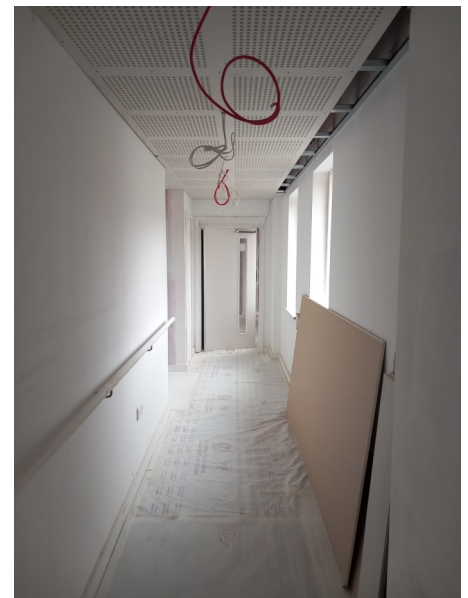
Works completed:

Upcoming works:

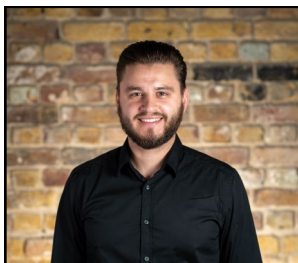
Snagging will continue, external 278 works will take place, floor finishes will continue, and final testing of all systems.

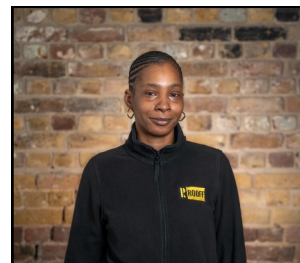
